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Greater Cambridge Local Plan Integrated Water Management Study

Stantec has been commissioned by South Cambridgeshire District Council and Cambridge City Council to carry out an Integrated Water Management Study to support the development of the Greater Cambridge Local Plan. The aim of the study is to look at all aspects of the water environment, to consider the sustainability of the growth being proposed in the Local Plan, the water infrastructure that will be required, and the measures needed to manage and protect the water environment.

The study will consist of three reports:

- An Outline Water Cycle Strategy, which will report on the baseline conditions of water resources, water quality, wastewater and flood risk in the area (as existing conditions, including development to date and the effects of climate change).
- A Detailed Water Cycle Strategy, which will consider the sustainability of the growth being proposed and the measures needed to protect the water environment, including new policies to be included in the Local Plan.
- A Strategic Flood Risk Assessment, which will look at all sources of flood risk in the area, including the effects of climate change. The Councils have a duty to prepare this report as a stand-alone document.
