This is a change to the current granted planning consent, in that the original planning consent has the same glass but in a horizontal sliding window design. <u>5.2 S/3887/19/LB 34 High Street</u> - To remove a single window (1920s) and replace with cob / clunch blockwork, leaving existing lintel in place to prevent any building changes.
